*Operation Nehemiah Missions International, Inc with the help of Beth Israel Messianic Congregation <http://www.bethisraelworshipcenter.org/b> was first incorporated as a USA faith base Christian Not for profit organization in the state of NJ in 1993 where it operated from 1993- 2002. Currently ONMI is incorporated in the state of MA. In 1995, it was granted 501-C – 3 Status. ONMI main office is in Lanesboro, MA, USA. Hope of the World is the Mission wing of Beth Israel Messianic Congregation. This year, through **Operation Nehemiah** we were able to assist persecuted believers in South Sudan with food, medical supplies transportation relief <http://www.hopeoftheworld.org/>*

Operation Nehemiah's main branch office is in Beth Israel (Borongole) Pageri Payam Magwi County, EE State, and South Sudan.

In Jan 2007, ONMI has been also registered as faith based Christian NGO with the Government of South Sudan (GOSS) <http://www.gossmission.org/goss/> has been operational for the last for 7 years with the local communities in South Sudan and 11 years in the refugees camps in Uganda and IDP camps in the South Sudan. The distribution of the some input to the community had been part of it.

In 2006 US Department of Commerce <http://www.commerce.gov/> issued License for Operation Nehemiah to conduct shipment of relief items to the South Sudan to help refugees returning from exile. Please see attachment exhibit

In March 2008, William Levi, The CEO and President of ONMI was nominated by MA's Northern Berkshire Community Coalition <http://www.nbccoalition.org/> to receive 2008, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Peace award because of his dedicated effort through Operation Nehemiah to bring support and for being the voice of the people of the South Sudan. 2004- 2010, Congressman John Olver, of the First Massachusetts Congressional district <http://www.house.gov/olver/contact/index.html> has been consistently encouraging the work of Operation Nehemiah in the South Sudan by assisting William Levi, the CEO and president of ONMI in expediting his annual traveling document from the Homeland Security office. He needs this document for traveling back and forth between the USA and the South Sudan. William Levi is a refugee from the Sudan residing in his district and he

has to travel a lot 2-3 times a year to South Sudan to monitor the work on the ground and report back here.

In 2008 -2009, with help of International Children Fund <http://www.icfaid.org/>, Operation Nehemiah received \$31 million of medical supplies.

In April 2008, with the support of International Children Fund, Wereld Nood Hulp <http://www.wnh-nl.org/> two 40ft containers worth at least \$500,000 are being shipped

From 1995-todate , with Support of VCY America, <http://www.vcyamerica.org> Operation Nehemiah has constructed 300ft Radio tower in Nimule to improve its broadcasting areas reaching to 500,000 people in Eastern and Central Equatoria and northern Uganda. Our Gospel radio station “Nehemiah Trumpet Call 97.3” has been broadcasting everyday and it has created very big difference in the locality through the gospel many people comes to church and give their lives to Jesus and many people change their life styles

In 2007- Operation Nehemiah Mission International with the support from Berkshire Medical centre, www.berkshiremedicalcenter.net/, International children Fund Nehemiah Health Clinic and Nehemiah mission’s house have been completed in our compound in (Beth Israel) Borongole in Pageri Payam and our mission compound in Nimule Payam.

In 2006 - Operation Nehemiah Mission International with support of Provision Foundation <http://provisionfoundation.org/> the Local Government of the Magwi county commissioner’s office and UNHCR we resettled 100 families’ heads building them house and give them farm tools as repartition is one of the program very carry out in our program

In 2007- ONMI have registered 20 families head and we are also building them house with tools.

In 2005-, Jesus is Lord transporters river transportation has been established on the Nile which carry 60 passenger, power by 70 HP Motor operating between Uganda and south Sudan in Nimule Town which is the gateway to south Sudan.

In 2005- Operation Nehemiah Mission International with CPA, Operation Nehemiah Mission International decided to move from Kampala and from refugee camps to South Sudan in Nimule and Pageri Payam Magwi county eastern equatorial state.

In 2004 - Operation Nehemiah Mission International constructed a bridge across river Eyibi a seasonal river with separated the main road from Beth Israel, the community we targeted for development.

In 2004, with the help of <http://blessingsforobedience.homestead.com>, Blessing for Obedience and new Tribes mission, solar power communication centre have been established. it was the first community communication centre in Eastern Equatoria state.

In 2004- With the help of Universal Aid Society, <http://universalaide.org/>, 8 40ft container were shipped in with many materials worth, \$2.5 million such as Tractors, medicine supplies, clothing, Bibles, Well drilling machines, Hospital supplies, building materials, foods items.

In 2003- Operation Nehemiah Mission International with the support of Church of Acts, from Wisconsin opened the Nehemiah Polytechnic Institute in the Alere refugee camps in Adjumani Uganda. In 2004 82 students were graduated from the institute with certificate in various technical skills.

In August 2003- Operation Nehemiah Mission International with the support from individual donors ,VCY AMERICA RADIO NETWORK <http://www.vcyamerica.org>, and Galcom International <http://www.galcom.org/>, Operation Nehemiah Mission International purchased and delivered \$90,000 mobile units and mobile gospel radio broadcasting station(Nehemiah trumpet call FM 97.3. Over 45.000 people received the gospel and medical outreached were conducted through using the mobile unit.

In 2003- Operation Nehemiah Mission International renovated a hospital that been in state of disrepair in Kiriadongo refugee camp, the project cost \$20.000 and 300 patients were treaded

In 2000- Operation Nehemiah Mission International in cooperation with bridge international, <http://www.bridgeinternational.org/> distributed \$ 15,000 provided support for 33 pastors to help churches and their families. And Serve life ministry donated \$ 25,000 to refugee in Uganda to start Micro bossiness .Women of good news were formed to start the training centre for treadle sewing machine to established micro business

August 1998-1999- Operation Nehemiah Mission International shipped 20ft container holding medical materials, educational materials, Bibles, clothing, and Bibles to the Kiriadongo Camp Masindi District Uganda 40.000 refugee people benefited.

May, 1997- Operation Nehemiah Mission International with Safe Harbor <http://www.safeharbor.us> delivered 4 plane loads containing \$500.000 worth of food, tools, medicine, Bibles, dry food, Bikes, educational material for the people of Tonj

September, 1996- Operation Nehemiah Mission International with the Voice of the martyrs, <http://www.persecution.com/> delivered four 40ft relief containers included farming tools Bibles ,medicines, Clothings, medical and dental equipments were distributed in IDP SPLA controlled area.

July, 1995- Operation Nehemiah Mission International, in co-operation with Americare, <http://www.americares.org/> delivered \$500.000 worth of relief supplies like Bibles, Clothing, Shoes, education materials, in IPD camps in Natinga in south Sudan and the goods were distributed.

Conclusion: After 10 years serving in the refugee and IDP camps, in 2004, one year prior to the signing of the Comprehensive Peace Agreement, we moved into South Sudan. We focused on providing hope in the Lord that the people would be able to return to their homeland to live and worship in peace. We delivered a mobile medical unit and the first Gospel Radio Station in the Sudan, built a health clinic and a mission house, planted crops, and established a church. The projects described in this proposal will enable us to take another major step in providing hope for our future.
